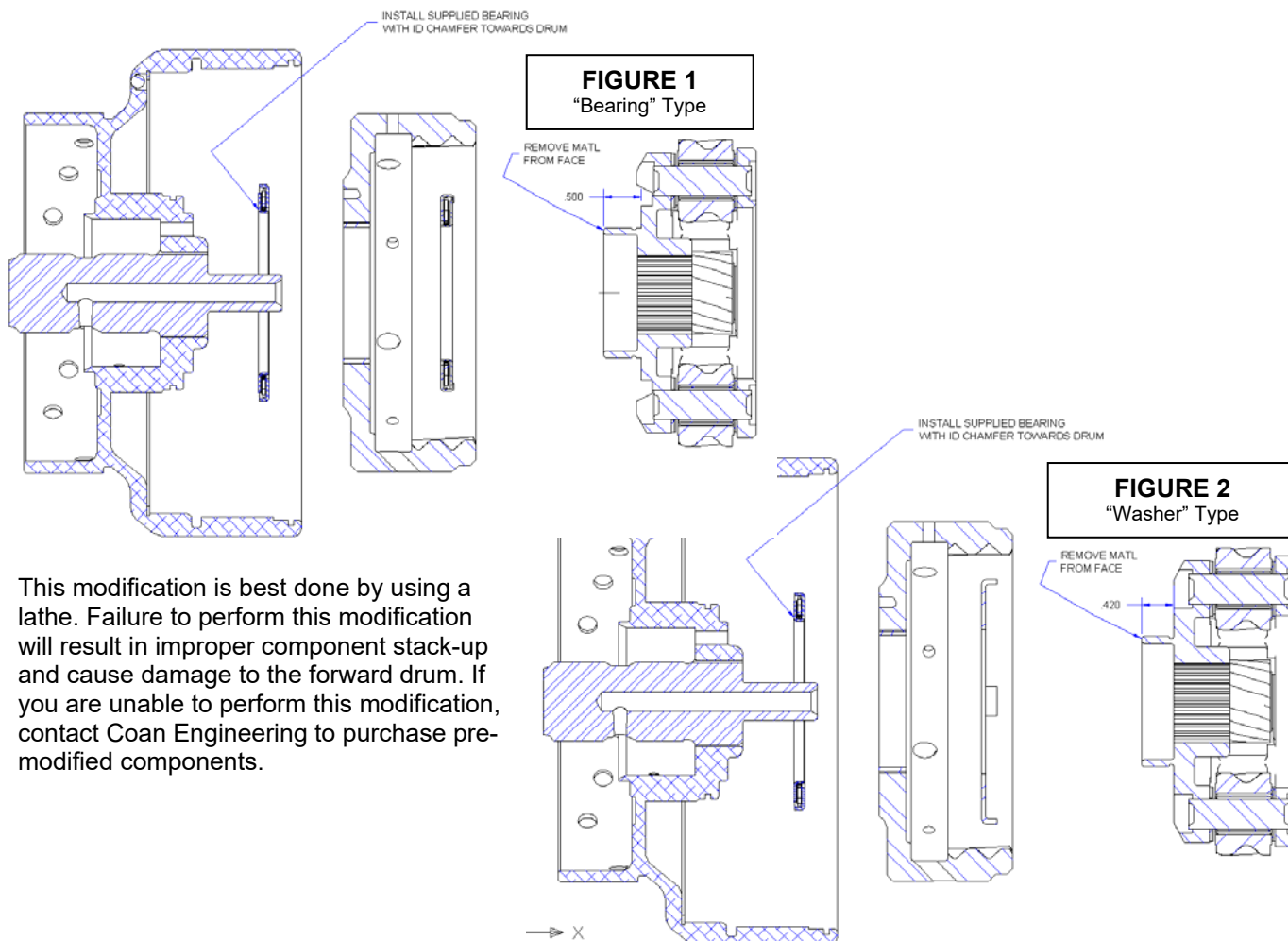


### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALUMINUM FORWARD DRUM (7075 BILLET) W/ OEM INPUT SHAFT, TH SPLINE COA-32812

Installation of COA-32812 Billet Aluminum Forward Drum w/OEM input shaft require one modification to the output carrier. The modifications depend on the style of the output carrier being used (OEM "Bearing" or "Washer" type). Refer to Figures 1 & 2



This modification is best done by using a lathe. Failure to perform this modification will result in improper component stack-up and cause damage to the forward drum. If you are unable to perform this modification, contact Coan Engineering to purchase pre-modified components.
