INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS 700R4 AND 2004R NON-LOCK UP CONVERTER CLUTCH VALVE PART #92847

COMPONENTS

- (1) Aluminum Plug
- (1) 5/16x18 Set Screws
 - 1. Remove stock lock-up valve and springs, parts: #227,#228, and #229. (figure A)
 - 2. Drive out cup plug located in position #25 in pump. (figure B)
 - 3. Tap hole #25 5/16 x 18 through to valve bore.
 - 4. Insert non-lockup valve as shown, with the side with two holes placed outward toward the outer edge of the pump.(figure A)
 - 5. Install valve stop and snap ring. #226 & #225 (figure A)
 - 6. Put a few drops of loc-tite on set screw and screw in hole #25. Tighten until valve is locked into place.
 - 7. Lock-up solenoid may be disconnected, but must be left in the stock location.
 - 8. <u>*Remove check ball and capsule*</u> from the end of the input shaft. (figure C)
